



Born and raised in Hamburg, MW entered Hamburg medical school in 1975 and graduated after one year at Glasgow medical school in 1981. 1982 and 1984 was spent as a postdoc at UCSF medical school in the Hormone Research Laboratory. After establishing the Laboratory for Brain Tumor Biology within the Department of Neurosurgery at the University Hamburg-Eppendorf, board certification and promotion to associate professor followed in 1992 and 1993 respectively. After passing on the offer for chairmanship in Düsseldorf, MW was confirmed director of the department of neurosurgery in Hamburg in 2002. With the specialization in neuro-oncology and neuro-vascular diseases, the publication list contains more than 200 Medline listed publications and about 50 book chapters. Among the offices held, the chairmanship of the EANS Committee for Neuro-Oncology 2003 to 2005, Secretary of the EANS 2003 to 2007, Collegiate of the neuro-science panel of the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft and Board Member of the European Brain Council are the most relevant.
