

Dr. Ugur was born in 1972. He graduated from from Cukurova University Medical School, Adana, Turkey in 1994. He completed his neurosurgery residency at the Neurosurgery Department of Ankara University Medical School, Turkey in 2001, and within the same year, conducted research on brain tumors as a visiting researcher at the Molecular Biology and Genetics Department of Bilkent University, Ankara, Turkey. He also completed the microsurgery course at Miami Jackson Memorial hospital, Miami, FL/USA.
